## Supplemental/Bid Bulletin for the Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Units Air-conditioned Motor Vehicle, 4x4 Pick-Up

Thursday, 28 September 2017

Addenda for the **Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Units Air-conditioned Motor Vehicle, 4x4 Pick-Up (AFMD, TAD, Research-PhP 14,300,000.00)** (PhilGEPS Ref. No. 4800881) has been issued to modify or amend the items as indicated in the <u>Invitation to Bid, Instructions to Bidders, Bid</u> Data Sheet and General Conditions of Contract which were issued earlier.

Such addenda shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

All prospective bidders must comply with the agreed specifications as detailed in the Supplemental/Bid Bulletin below:

1. The Item no. 2 under the <u>Section I. Invitation to Bid</u> (page 7 of the Bidding Documents) for the Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Units Airconditioned Motor Vehilcles, 4x4 Pick-Up shall be:

"The PhilFIDA now invites bids for the Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Units Airconditioned Motor Vehicles, 4x4 Pick-up. Delivery of the goods shall be in accordance with the Delivery Schedule under Section VI. Schedule of Requirements. Bidders should have completed, within **Three (3)** Years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders."

2. The last paragraph in Item 5.5 of the sub-topic "Eligible Bidders" of the <u>Section II. Instruction to Bidders</u> (page 16 of the Bidding Documents) shall be:

"If the prospective bidder opts to submit a committed Line of Credit, it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC to be bid with the validity of **90** days from the date of bid opening. If issued by a foreign universal or commercial bank, it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a local universal or commercial bank."

3. The third paragraph in Clause 5.4 of the <u>Section III Bid Data Sheet</u> (page 41 of the Bidding Documents) shall be:

"Failure to submit a copy of Single Largest Completed Contract with proof of Completion or a failure against the veracity of such shall be a ground for disqualification of the Bidder for award and forfeiture of the bid security. For this purpose, similar contract shall refer to the supply and delivery of **any 4-wheel motor vehicles**."

4. The Item 17.3 of the sub-topic "Warranty" of the <u>Section IV General</u> <u>Conditions of Contract</u> (page 54 of Bidding Documents) shall be:

"In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier for a minimum period specified in the <u>SCC</u>. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by, at the Supplier's option, either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of every progress payment, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of the total Contract Price or other such amount if so specified in the <u>SCC</u>. The said amounts shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period specified in the <u>SCC</u>; provided, however, that the Supplies delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under this Contract have been fully met."
